Presenting the Home Front Hero Award

CONGRESSWOMAN LORI TRAHAN



The Durkin Foundation would like to present Congresswomen Lori Trahan with the "Home Front Hero Award" that recognizes those individuals that are on the front lines battling, advocating and giving tirelessly towards the families and individuals who are impacted by Alzheimer's Disease, Intellectual Disabilities, and Veteran Affairs. This year we will be honoring Congresswoman Lori Trahan, a proven and dynamic leader.

Lori has spent much of her career as an executive, an entrepreneur and business consultant, building successful companies, and bringing practical solutions to complex problems.

Lori was born and raised in a working-class family in Lowell. Her father was a union ironworker and her mother was a domestic worker who juggled various part time jobs while raising four girls. The first in her family to graduate from college, Lori earned a scholarship to play Division 1 volleyball at Georgetown University. She joined the staff of former Congressman Marty Meehan as a scheduler, eventually working her way up to Chief of Staff. During her time on the Hill, Lori helped Meehan to pass a landmark campaign finance reform bill as well as legislation that safeguarded the rights of gay service members in the U.S. military.

Following her public service, Lori began working in the private sector as the only female executive at a tech company before moving on to cofound a woman owned and operated consulting firm, Concire, where she advised various companies on business strategy, how to create the conditions for employees especially women - to thrive. She and her husband, Dave, currently reside in Westford and are raising two young girls, Grace and Caroline, while keeping tabs on her three grown stepsons, Thomas, Dean, and Christian. Lori is also one of five caregivers for her father who has had MS since 1994.

Lori is focused on fighting for working families on issues such as affordable health care, quality public education, workforce development, the



environment, and working to end the pain and suffering of the opioid crisis. She is also focused on keeping the brave men and women now serving in our military safe as well as helping veterans and their families. Lori is also the first Portuguese-American woman elected to Congress.
